

Participant/Parental Guidelines

Remember learning **sports fundamentals** & having **fun** is our goal.

1. Please remember our coaches are volunteers, and they all have different coaching techniques however; all will be giving their best efforts to teach and educate your child to the best of their ability. If you encounter a problem with a coach I urge you to approach the coach **first** and try to work out any misunderstandings. If the problem is not resolved to your liking please feel free to contact the Recreation Department immediately at (330) 626-3802. If we are not in the office please leave a message and we will return your call as quickly as possible.
2. It is in your child's best interest to have you at his/her practices and games. Your child should **not** be dropped off at his/her practice/game for any reason other than circumstances beyond your control. If you must leave your child, please make proper arrangements with the coach or another parent, and leave necessary information to contact you. Our coaches volunteer to teach the fundamentals of the sport and **need** your help in supervising the children who participate. **All children must be picked up from his/her practice or game on time. If we find that this rule is being abused we will first give a warning, and second your child may be asked to leave the program.**
3. Your child should bring a water bottle or sports drink to each practice/game.
4. Game shirts are provided, and will arrive as quickly as possible, until then coaches may ask their players to wear the same color on game days.
5. All schedules are subject to change and may be modified at any time during the season.
6. We ask that you collect all personal items and garbage before you leave any facility.
7. Streetsboro Parks & Recreation will determine cancellations due to severe weather. Coaches will contact you if we decide to cancel a practice/game. **If you do not receive a phone call you should attend practices/games as scheduled.**

The Parent/Spectator Pledge

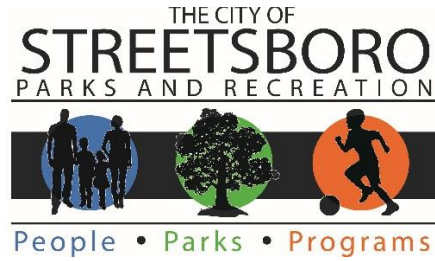
