

As of 3/17/2020, the Streetsboro Police Department has implemented new practices as a result of COVID-19. Our goal is to protect our community and our first responders.

- If you have an emergency, call 911 for police and fire. Emergency personnel will respond as always. In our commitment to maintaining the safety of our residents and our employees, Dispatchers will be asking additional screening information on any police or fire related calls requiring an officer or EMS response to your location. When possible, the first responders should be met outside.
- Non-emergency police reports will be taken over the phone. Dispatch will take contact information and an officer will be assigned to call you as soon as they are available. Please contact Dispatch at our non-emergency line 330-626-4976.
- We encourage everyone to call the police department before coming to the station for any non-emergency. Dispatchers will screen your call and determine the appropriate response.

These changes are temporary and are designed to keep everyone as safe as possible.
