Need assistance with an item?

We will have a few volunteers available to pick up large items for Streetsboro Seniors & Handicapped individuals. Pick-ups MUST be scheduled ahead of time by calling Streetsboro Parks & Rec at (330) 626-3802. This service is limited to 20 individuals. Volunteers are NOT permitted to enter anyone's residents, so items MUST be placed outside. Deadline to schedule a pick-up is 9/18/2020.

If you need assistance with an item you MUST call the Parks & Recreation Office by Friday, September 18 to schedule a pick-up at (330) 626-3802. We will have a few volunteers on hand to assist Seniors and Handicapped individuals with the removal of larger items.

For residents dropping off large items - please note we will have equipment and operator available at the Streetsboro Service Department to assist with large item removal from your vehicles.

*Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, humidifiers, dehumidifiers and water coolers are among the types of household appliances that contain Freon. Please be aware that any item containing Freon must have the Freon removed and tagged by a certified technician PRIOR to any scheduled pick up.

tires, cement, hazardous materials, batteries, gas tanks, propane tanks, or liquids.
